



The CHAMP Family program will provide participants with up to 12-months of rental assistance and placement within CHAT owned or master-leased housing.

CHAMP Family will also provide close and supportive case management. Participants will benefit from weekly check-ins with CHAMP case management, as individualized barriers to housing are identified, action plans are developed in overcoming them, and success in goal achievements are obtained. The end goal will be that families are in their own, affordable and sustainable, housing within the program time allowance.

Examples of barriers to housing that will be worked on with close case management support would be;

- Eviction History
- Poor Credit
- Employment
- Childcare
- Documentation Replacement
- And many other unique circumstances that impact their ability to obtain sustainable housing.

Program participant eligibility requirements will include the following, and may also require additional information based on individual circumstances;

- Supportive documentation of their burn scar address existing within the Camp fire disaster zone as of November 8th 2018.
- Must have custody of minor children, or provide documentation of impending custody/reunification.
- Must have a form of income.
